# **Pride in Cheltenham March - Road** Closure

The Pride in Cheltenham March will be taking place on Saturday 18<sup>th</sup> May 2024. To enable the march to take place, the A4015 will be closed between the junctions with the Promenade and Imperial Gardens. The closure order covers the entirety of the march route (from John Lewis to Imperial Gardens) between 10:45am - 12:00pm, but it will be managed on a rolling basis so no section of road is shut for longer than necessary. The march will depart from John Lewis at 11:30am, and is due to arrive at Imperial Gardens by 12:00pm.

#### 3.5 March Route

The march route is pictured below.




Figure 1 - March Route

The forming up point starts on the high street, outside John Lewis and Partners. The march continues north-westerly along the high street before turning left onto the promenade. The march procession follows the promenade until it joins the A4015, where the group enters the finishing point at Imperial Gardens.
