Freedom of information compliance statistics - 2025 quarter one

Totals for quarter one:

- 211 freedom of information requests (FOIs) were raised
- 175 or 83% of FOIs were completed within 20-day statutory deadline
- The remaining **36** took over 20 days to respond
 - Of the 36, 25 were given extensions. This was slightly higher than normal as a result of movement over to the new system
 - Most delays were due to the volume of information being collated, the time required to review the material to determine whether any exemptions under the act apply and officer availability

Graph: FOI and EIR outcome



