SECOND ANNUAL REVIEW NOTIFICATION OF INCLUSIONS

The Index of Buildings of Local Interest identifies buildings and structures that do not meet the strict criteria for statutory listing yet still make a special contribution to Cheltenham by virtue of their history, appearance, character or cultural value. The Index currently contains around 450 buildings and structures that are valued by the community for these reasons.

The Index is reviewed annually and the public are consulted on proposed inclusions. As part of the latest review the buildings and structures below have been short-listed for inclusion on the index:

Temple Garth, Oakley Road, Battledown, Cheltenham

36 & 38 Shurdington Road, Cheltenham

St Kenelm House, Shurdington Road, Cheltenham

Park House, 39 Park Place, Cheltenham

59-83 (odd) Hatherley Road, Cheltenham

Sub Station, Moorend Road, Cheltenham

Inclusion on the Index does <u>not</u> affect any planning rights at the properties identified. However, the Council will give careful consideration to the local importance of the property and its setting when considering any applications for planning or other consents. The Council may consider action to protect the building if it is considered to be under threat of demolition or damage.

The public consultation runs from 27th October 2009 to 5:00pm on 23rd November 2009.
