

HONEYBOURNE LINE PART CLOSURE

As part of improvements to the Honeybourne Line, we have been able to secure external funding to remove the conifers along the main footpath boundary between the play area open space to the end of the Travis Perkins yard. The removal of these conifer trees will make the area lighter, more inviting, improve the security for adjacent properties, enable better CCTV coverage, prevent further root damage to the footpath and reduce annual maintenance costs.

This work will commence on the 9th February between 8.30am and 4.30pm, Monday to Friday for approximately two weeks.

A more appropriate scheme will be planted along this boundary in Autumn 2015 when it is best to plant mature trees.

Cyclists should use alternative routes from the Queen's Road, Malvern Road, St George's Road or Honeybourne Way entrances.

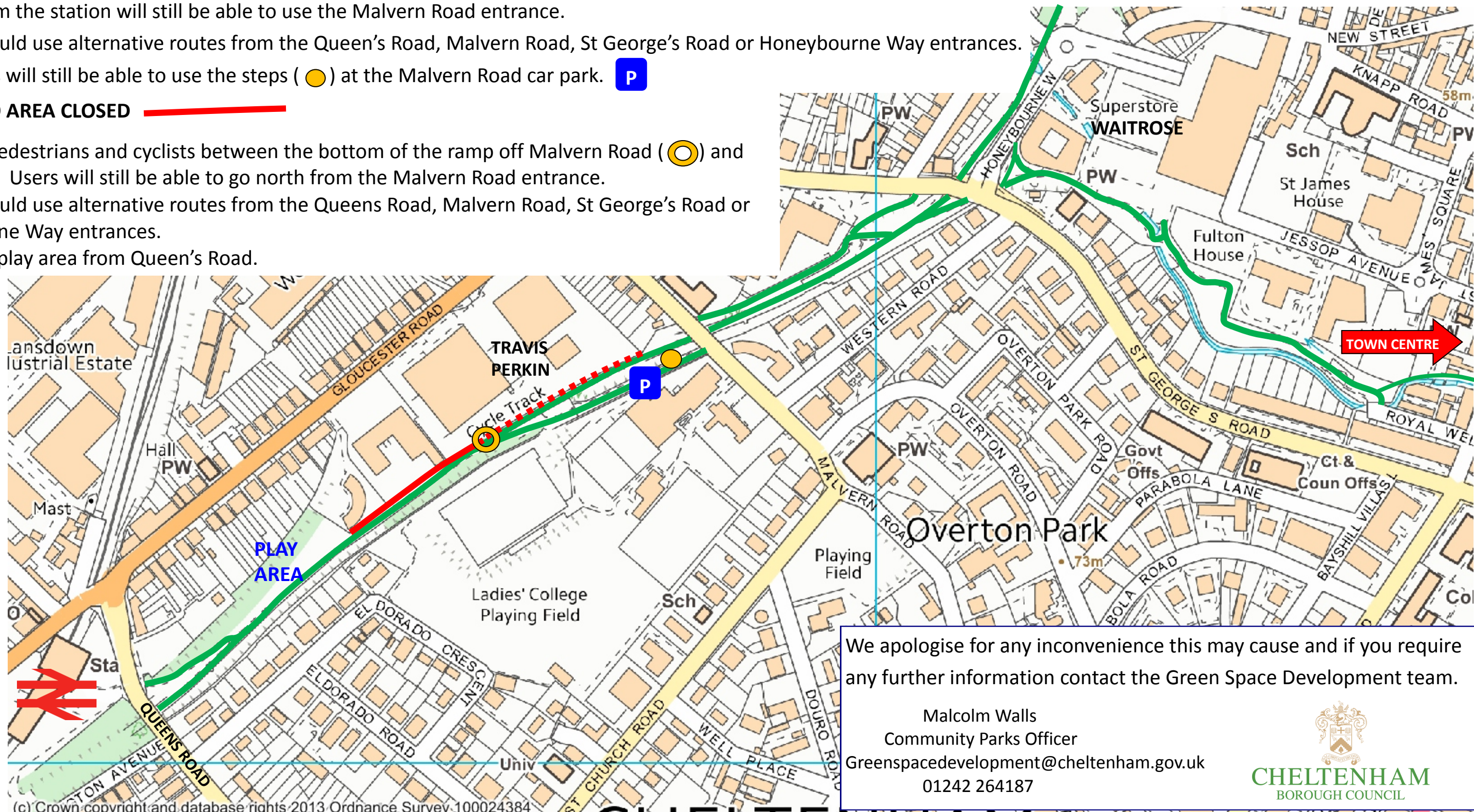
Pedestrians will still be able to use the steps (●) at the Malvern Road car park. P
