The Minster Alleyways project is part of a wider scheme to improve the churchyard and links between the Minster, The Wilson, the Library and the town. The main aim of this wider scheme is the development of the 'Cultural Quarter' of the town.

The success of the wider scheme is dependent on much greater pedestrian connectivity with the High Street and Clarence Street. This is the aim of the Minster Alleyways project.

This initial stage considers links to the High Street:



between Co-operative Travel and Specsavers



between Patisserie Valerie and Snappy Snaps



between Paparrito's and Shoezone

Safety

- An increase in the level of activity will give an improvement in safety
- Light levels will be increased through the installation of new lighting in imaginative and appropriate ways

Resurfacing

- New or reclaimed yorkstone paving will be laid to tie in with the High Street where possible
- Drainage issues will be resolved through re-profiling of the surface to direct water towards drainage channels and gullies
- Gateway artistic elements will mark routes through to the churchyard based on themes developed by a working group

Artwork

- Artists will be commissioned to produce artwork which will relate to the Rose Window of the Minster and local history
- Artists will work with the local community to produce designs
- Artwork could be mounted on walls, incorporated into surfacing and as part of street furniture
