### **Partnership Expressions of Interest**

#### **Preferred provider framework for housing development**

The Gloucester, Cheltenham and Tewkesbury Affordable Housing Partnership has formed in response to the proposed Joint Core Strategy (JCS) which details the requirement to plan for approximately 30,500 new homes across the JCS area over the plan period to 2031.

The Partnership is undertaking a selection process for preferred providers on the proposed strategic allocations across the JCS area (see Part 6 of the submission document November 2014). It is estimated that the strategic allocations will provide up to 12,000 new homes of which up to 40% are to be affordable housing.

We are inviting expressions of interest from registered providers of social housing who would like to apply for preferred provider status for a 5 year period.
