Second Adult Rebate claim form

You should fill in this form if you only want to claim Second Adult Rebate. If this is not the case, please contact 01242 264341 for a different form.

Second Adult Rebate is a form of council tax support for council tax payers, who do not have a partner, but share their home with someone over 18 on a low income who is not a paying lodger.

You may still be able to claim Second Adult Rebate if you have a partner, but they have to be a disregarded person under the council tax regulations. If you have a partner please contact the above number for further advice for completing the form.

This rebate is not based on the council tax payer's income, but that of the other adult(s) in the property – they are known as second adult(s). The amount of rebate you get depends on the total gross income of your second adult(s).

- If they work for an employer, we must see their last five weekly wage slips or two monthly payslips. If they are self-employed, we will need to see their latest trading accounts.
- If they get Income Support, Jobseeker's Allowance, Employment & Support Allowance,
 Universal credit, Incapacity Benefit, Attendance Allowance, Disability Living Allowance,
 Personal Independence payments or Pension Credit, then we will **not need to see proof** of
 this income if they sign below to give us permission to check their details with the Department
 for Work & Pensions.
- We will need to see original documents for any other income or savings.

How we collect and use information

We will use the information we collect on this form and supporting evidence to process your claim for housing benefit/council tax support. We may pass the information to the Department for Work and Pensions and HM Revenue and Customs if the law allows this.

We may check the information you provide or information someone gives us about you with other information held by us. We may also get information from organisations or give them information to check the details we have are accurate. This is to prevent or detect crime or to protect public funds in other ways if the law allows this. These other organisations include government departments and other local authorities.

We are the Data Controller for the purpose of the Data Protection Act 1998. This means we are responsible for keeping to the Data Protection Act. If you want to know more about what information we have about you or the way we use that information, please see our fair processing notice on our website or contact us.

Changes you must tell us about

You must tell us if:

- anyone moves into or out of your home, including lodgers and sub-tenants;
- the income of anyone living with you, including benefits, changes;
- you, or anyone living with you, becomes a student, goes on a youth training scheme, goes into hospital or a nursing home, goes into prison or changes or leaves a job;
- you move or are going to be away from home for more than a month;
- anything you have told us about changes.

This is not a full list. If you are not sure, ask us for advice. You must tell us about any changes in writing as a phone call may not be enough.

What happens now?

When you have filled in the form, sign it and return it to us at the address on the front of the form together with original documents to prove your non-dependants' income and your identity. Supporting documents will be photocopied and returned to you.

Valuable items such as passport, building society passbooks should not be posted but brought into the customer service desk at the Municipal Offices between 10:00am and 4:00pm (Monday to Friday) where we can check and photocopy them free of charge.

We will contact you within seven days of receiving your form, to either ask for extra information or tell you about your award.

If you get Second Adult Rebate we will take this off your council tax and send a new bill telling you what you have to pay.
