## Disclosure and Barring Service (DBS) - identity document requirements Guidance for applicants for hackney carriage and private hire driver licences

All applicants for new / renewal hackney carriage or private hire driver licences must supply an enhanced DBS check, or evidence that they are an up-to-date member of the DBS update service. Applicants for a DBS check must provide the appropriate evidence of identity from the list below.

Applicants must provide at least **three** separate forms of ID - between them they **must** show your current **address**, your full, current **name**, and your **date of birth**.

At least **one** of the documents must be from **Group 1** (see below); the other two documents can be from any of the groups shown. If you are unable to provide anything from **Group 1** please contact us as soon as possible to discuss alternative ways to verify your identity, which is likely to delay your application.
