

**NOTICE OF APPLICATION FOR REVIEW OF A
PREMISES LICENCE UNDER SECTION 51 OF THE
LICENSING ACT 2003**

Notice is given that an application has been made by Cheltenham Borough Council, as the licensing authority, for the review of the premises licence in respect of St James Store, 22 St James Street, Cheltenham, GL52 2SH.

The grounds for the review are:

On Tuesday 26 June 2018, Immigration Compliance & Enforcement Officers from the Home Office visited St James Store and a person was arrested on the premises for Immigration Offences. The premises was issued with a Civil Penalty Notice. The application for review is being made on the grounds of the prevention of crime and disorder.

Responsible authorities as defined in the Licensing Act 2003 and other people may make representations to Cheltenham Borough Council. All representations must be in writing and be made within a 28 day period commencing on 31st July 2018 and ending on 27th August 2018 and must be sent to:

The licensing register and the grounds for review may be viewed during normal office hours at the above address.

It is an offence under section 158 of the Licensing Act 2003 knowingly or recklessly to make a false statement in connection with an application and the maximum fine for which a person is liable on summary conviction for the offence is up to level 5 on the standard scale (£5,000).
