
Matter 4: Green Belt and Green Infrastructure

Main Issue: Green Belt


7 For Leckhampton Fields, guidance was provided by the JCS Inspector in her report. She stated it would be for the CP to identify the detailed boundaries of the LGS. Can the scale and extent of the proposed LGS be fully justified in accordance with the JCS, and National policy and guidance?

- 1. The Inspector has requested that where participants have already set out their full cases within their existing representations there should ordinarily be no need for the production of further written statements in response to the MIQs.
- 2. We have set out clearly in our original representations (ID 1221) to the Submission Plan our concerns regarding the detailed boundary of the LGS at Leckhampton where it adjoins what is shown as MD5. The smallholdings along the north side of the footpath should be excluded from LGS consistent with the development boundary of MD5 and the Proposals Map. The LGS boundary plan should be amended for consistency.
