Cheltenham Borough Council's Lifeline alarm service can be a vital addition to ensuring the safety and independence of vulnerable people, in their own home and garden, 24 hours a day.

The service provides a sense of security and also has a positive impact in reducing hospital admissions.

Independence and peace of mind - 365 days a year

The Lifeline service is an important preventive measure that can enable a quick response when help is needed.





THE DETAILS

WHAT YOU GET

The Lifeline Alarm Service is a quick and efficient way to get help via our digital alarm.

It consists of a special unit which connects to the monitoring centre using a roaming sim. The alarm is supplied with a pendant which can be worn around the neck or on the wrist.

The benefit of the digital alarm is that it does not require a telephone point or line and can be placed anywhere within the home as long as there is a 13-amp socket.

The alarms have a long standby battery life so in the event of a power cut they continue to work as normal.

The charge for the service is around 60p per day + VAT, if applicable, which is paid monthly in advance. There is also a setup fee of £48 excluding VAT.

The cost includes:

- Hire of lifeline unit and pendant
- Maintenance and repair of the unit and pendant 7 days per week
- 24-hour / 7 day a week monitoring service from the monitoring centre

How to apply:

Additional equipment is also available, such as falls detectors for those who are more unsteady on their feet, and smoke and carbon monoxide detectors.

All of the equipment is linked to the monitoring centre providing 24/7 cover through the digital base unit.

The team can now also supply and fit Supra C500 key safes.
