51%* of all waste collected in Cheltenham was recycled thanks to the residents of Cheltenham

In 2018/2019 residents across Cheltenham recycled and re-used 24,958 tonnes of waste, including glass, tins, cans, paper, cardboard, food and plastics

**Please note residual waste (refuse) is now sent to the EFW (Energy from Waste) plant at Javelin Park (Gloucestershire County Council function)
