Running the #reducewaste campaign, Kelly has been helping to distribute free food from Tesco, Asda and Waitrose to the local community. As of 13 May the project had provided 709 food packages, benefiting 2135 people in those households - and all with good food which would otherwise have ended up in landfill.

Kelly and her teammate, Ali, coordinate donations from local residents and businesses. Together with their volunteers they have been delivering essential supplies to people who need to stay home. Kelly also does shopping for residents of Honeybourne Gate and has been helping the West End Partnership to support refugee families.

Other projects include a morale boosting community photography competition, which had a great response; and through funding of the community chest fund, a local resident is offering a free plant to anyone locally to "Grow their own".

"The #ReduceWaste food project was started in September 2019 but since coronavirus it has been an important source of food support for the community of St Peter's & The Moors and wider Cheltenham. We reacted quickly to the pandemic, offering support to those in need and identifying who were prepared to help our community. This project could not happen without our amazing group of volunteers and I feel blessed to have these wonderful people involved" Kelly
