



What can I put in my recycling boxes and blue bag?

Follow these simple steps to help sort your recycling!



In one green recycling box please put...

Plastic bottles, pots, tubs & trays

- Wash & squash, pop in your kerbside recycling box
- No plastic bags or film
- Lids stay on



Metal tins, cans aerosols and clean foil

- Wash & squash cans and tins, pop in your kerbside recycling
- Scrunch your foil
- Make sure your aerosols are empty



In another green recycling box please put...

Glass bottles and jars

- Rinse and pop in your kerbside recycling box
- Lids stay on



In another green recycling box please put...

Paper, newspapers and magazines

- Clean dry paper only
- No brown paper



In your blue bag please put...

Cardboard

- Brown corrugated or light card
- Clean dry cardboard and brown paper
- Flatten and tear to fit inside the bag
- Did you know torn cardboard, egg boxes and tubes can be home composted instead



In one of your green recycling boxes please put...

Textiles

All clean bagged dry textiles, clothing, shoes, belts & bags can be recycled at the kerbside. Pop them in a tied bag and put into one of your green recycling boxes



In one of your green recycling boxes please put...

Small waste electrical and electronic equipment (WEEE) and batteries

Pop them in a tied bag and place them in your recycling box



In your food waste caddy please put...

Food waste

Please put food scraps into your food waste caddy – e.g. egg shells, fruit and veg peelings
