

APPLICATION FOR PRIOR NOTIFICATION OF PROPOSED DEVELOPMENT IN RESPECT OF PERMITTED DEVELOPMENT BY ELECTRONIC COMMUNICATIONS CODE OPERATORS

National Requirements Checklist

- A completed form or written description of the proposed development
- A plan indicating the proposed location
- The appropriate fee
- Evidence that the developer has given notice of the proposed development in accordance with A.3(1) of Part 24 of Schedule 2 to the General Permitted Development Order 1995 appropriate
- Where the proposed development consists of the installation of a mast within three kilometres of the perimeter of an aerodrome evidence that the developer has notified the Civil Aviation Authority, the Secretary of State for Defence or the Aerodrome operator in accordance with A.3(2) of Part 24 of Schedule 2 to the General Permitted Development Order 1995

Local Requirements Checklist

You may be required to include some or all of the following. You can check with an officer prior to submission, but some requirements may not be identified until the application has been submitted in which case you will be informed as an application progresses:

- Acoustic report where relevant
- Any other relevant additional information
- Area of search
- Existing and proposed cell coverage plans
- Details of alternative sites rejected with a justification for rejecting them: This should include existing masts, structures and other buildings within the search area and where the reason is that the coverage is not good enough cell coverage plans for the rejected alternatives
- Explanation if no alternatives considered

- Map showing the relationship of the application site to schools and other telecommunication equipment in the vicinity
- Signed declaration that the equipment and installation fully complies with the ICNIRP requirements
- Statement of community involvement
- Supplementary Information Template (as set out in Annex F of the Code of Best Practice on Mobile Phone Network Development)
- Technical information including the frequency, modulation characteristics, power output and the height of the proposed antenna
- Technical justification — details about the purpose of the site and why the particular development is required
- Tree survey/Arboricultural implications
- Visual impact assessment where relevant
- Photos and Photomontages
- Any other plan/s, information or statements as may be reasonably required

Applicants are referred to Planning Policy Guidance Note 8 *Telecommunications* (2001), the *Code of Best Practice on Mobile Phone Network Development* (2002) for a complete discussion on the terms as set above.
