Hi Sophie

Please find below our responses to Sections 3 and 4 of the attached Pegasus Educational Needs Assessment as you requested. I have also attached the GCC response to the planning consultation for convenience, as I refer to it below.

Paragraph 3.4 – we agree that Oakley Farm is in the Whaddon Primary School Planning Area and the Cheltenham Secondary School Planning Area, which include the schools listed in paragraph 3.4.

Paragraph 3.5 – we do not agree on the order of the three nearest primary schools by walking distance.

we agree that St Mary's Infant and Junior are 0.8 miles away.

we do not agree the walking distances to Oakwood (GCC 0.9 miles vs Pegasus 0.8 miles) and Holy Apostles (GCC 1.1 miles vs Pegasus 0.6 miles).

we agree that Pittville is the closest secondary (GCC 1.5 miles vs Pegasus 1.4 miles), and Balcarras is second closest (GCC 2.3 miles vs Pegasus 1.6 miles),

with other schools over 3 miles away.

Paragraph 4.2 – we agree that there are 619 early years places registered for 1,215 children in the Whaddon Primary Planning Area. Consequently, there is no spare capacity and we require a contribution.

Paragraph 4.3 – GCC does not hold details of the number of advertised vacancies at individual nurseries.

The numbers of vacancies can change rapidly, and details are considered to be commercially sensitive by some providers so it is not possible to collect or verify that information about advertised vacancies is up-to-date and accurate.

Paragraph 4.4 – we agree the numbers of school places and numbers on roll shown in the 2018-2023 School Places Strategy for academic year 2018/19.

Paragraph 4.5 – The latest school census information from January 2021 is as follows

Paragraph 4.7 – Please refer to the attached education response to the planning consultation for full details of our position. In summary:

There is no spare early years capacity, see paragraph 4.2 above.

There is no spare capacity at the nearest primary school St Mary's Infant and Junior.

Whilst there was spare capacity of 123 places at primary schools in 2018/19 in the wider area (this has reduced to 98 spare places as at Census January 2021); there are 359 dwellings already planned or permitted that are forecast to generate additional demand for 147 extra primary school places, and any spare capacity will be allocated to developments on a first-come first-served basis. These developments are:

Starvehall Farm - 10/01243/OUT – permitted 2015 - Under construction, 280 qualifying dwellings, 115 primary places 102 Prestbury Rd - 17/01266/FUL – permitted, 30 qualifying dwellings, 12 primary places Premier Products, Bouncers Lane – 20/00780/FUL, 49 qualifying dwellings, 20 primary places

There is no spare capacity at either of the two nearest secondary schools. The other schools in the Cheltenham Secondary Planning Area are over the statutory walking distance of 3 miles from Oakley Farm.
