FIRST ANNUAL REVIEW NOTIFICATION OF INCLUSIONS Addendum to Previous Public Consultation

The Index of Buildings of Local Interest identifies buildings and structures that do not meet the strict criteria for statutory listing yet still make a special contribution to Cheltenham by virtue of their history, appearance, character or cultural value. The Index currently contains around 450 buildings and structures that are valued by the community for these reasons.

The Index is reviewed annually and the public are consulted on proposed amendments. As part of the latest review the buildings and structures below have been short-listed for inclusion on the index but, for the reasons noted, they were excluded from the original consultation.

1 The Verneys and 15 The Verneys

The Span housing development at Verney Close has been included on the Index for its architectural merit. 1 & 15 The Verneys are part of the same development but were not identified in the previous public consultation. The Council intends to include them on the Index.

Elephant Mosaics, Grosvenor Place

The previous consultation was incomplete because ownership was not known. The identity of the owner has now been established and this is an opportunity to undertake full consultation.

Electric Box and Railway Bridge, Leckhampton Road

The previous consultation was incomplete because ownership was not known. The identity of the owner has now been established and this is an opportunity to undertake full consultation.

Inclusion on the Index does not affect any planning rights at the properties identified. However, the Council will give careful consideration to the local importance of the property when considering any applications for planning or other consents. The Council may consider action to protect the building if it is considered to be under threat of demolition or damage.

The public consultation runs from **3rd March 2009 to 5:00pm on 31st March 2009.**
